
LIVING IN GOSHEN





The Bible tells us that we must allow God's Word to be a lamp to our feet and a light to our path. So let's light up our life with some scriptures that teach us how to please God.


Your word is a lamp for my feet, a light on my path. (Psalm 119:105)

Let's see what the Word of God tells us about: **THE FEAR OF THE LORD**.

In Isaiah 11:2-3 it says:

"The Spirit of the Lord will rest on him - the Spirit of wisdom and of understanding, the Spirit of counsel and of might, the Spirit of the knowledge and fear of the Lord - and he will delight in the fear of the Lord."

Proverbs 1:7 tells us:

"The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge, but fools despise wisdom and instruction."


And Psalm 147:11 says:

"The Lord delights in those who fear him, who put their hope in his unfailing love."

"The fear of the Lord" is not being afraid of God, but doing what He wants, showing Him respect and treating Him as our King. "Delight" means to feel happy or joyful – this is how we must feel when we fear the Lord. We must be filled with joy to walk in the ways of the Lord, and to choose what He desires. This is a key to get wisdom! When we delight in the fear of the Lord, He delights in us and we want to please Him all of the time.




Read Proverbs 1 to learn more about the fear of the Lord and wisdom.


