



The Bible tells us that we must allow God's Word to be a lamp to our feet and a light to our path. So let's light up our life with some scriptures that teach us how to please God.


Your word is a lamp for my feet, a light on my path. (Psalm 119:105)

Let's continue looking at what the Word of God tells us about: **THE FEAR OF THE LORD**.

Psalm 34:11 says:

"Come my children, listen to me. I will teach you the Fear of the Lord."

Proverbs 14:26 tells us:

"Whoever fears the Lord has a secure fortress, and for their children it will be a refuge.

And verse 27 says:

"The fear of the Lord is a fountain of life, turning a person from the snares of death."

In Psalm 34:7 we see that:

"The angel of the Lord encamps around those who fear him, and he delivers them."


