Finally, be strong in the Lord and in His mighty power.
Put on the full Armor of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes.



PUT ON GOD'S ARMOR

We have learned that the Armor of God has different parts. Let us take a closer look at what each part of the armor means. In Ephesians 6:14, God tells us about two pieces of the armor, the "Belt of Truth" and the "Breastplate of Righteousness".

Truth means to say and do only what is accurate according to God's Word! Righteousness means to do what is right according to God's word.

When we say and do only what is accurate according to God's Word, we are wearing the Belt of Truth. When we do what is right according to God's word, we are wearing the Breastplate of Righteousness. Wearing the full Armor of God, defends* us against the enemy!

Ephesians 6:14 "Stand firm then, with the belt of truth buckled around your waist, with the breastplate of righteousness in place."

We must remember:

- We put on the Belt of Truth by saying and doing what is accurate.
- We put on the Breastplate of Righteousness by doing the right thing that pleases God.
- O God desires that we wear His full Armor.




COLORING ZONE



God's Truth vs. The Devil's Lies

Mark was teased by some mean boys in his class because he stammered. At first, he ignored their ugly words, but after a few months of their teasing, he became less vocal in class. Read Psalm 139:14. How should Mark respond to being teased?



Righteousness vs. Things that Displease God



Lisa and Sara have been best friends since they started Project Heritage. One day Sara notices that Lisa is viewing an inappropriate video on YouTube and confronts her about it. Lisa asks Sara to keep it a secret and even invites her to join in.

Sara loves Lisa and does not want to lose her friendship, but she also remembers what 1 John 3:7 says about being led astray. **Read 1 John 3:7.** What should Sara do?

Let's Reflect: Was it ever difficult to wear your Belt of Truth or Breastplate of Righteousness? What can you do to ensure you always wear the Armor of God even when it is difficult?

RED LIGHT GREEN LIGHT, FIND THE TRUTH!




Parents: Have your child stand a few steps in front of you with a belt around their waist. As you call out a statement, ask your child to say whether that statement is true or a lie of the enemy. Have your child tighten their belt after each statement.

If the statement is correctly identified as a truth or a lie, direct them to take a step forward. If the wrong answer is given, they must stay put, so that they will be more guarded against the enemy's lies. They can only move forward when the statement is correctly identified as truth or a lie.

Here are some statements that can be used:

- ✓ Truth: God loves [Insert Childs name].
- ✓ *Truth:* The Word of God is truth!
- ✓ Truth: Doing the right thing pleases God.
- x Lie: Throwing tantrums pleases God.
- x **Lie:** Lying to my parents to avoid punishment is ok.



At the end of the game, have your child call out these declarations:

- 1. God's Word is True!
- 2. I will tell the truth at all times







Here's a game you can play with a parent or older sibling. The aim of the game is to quickly identify the part of the armor that is worn or not worn based on the statements given (Belt of Truth or Breastplate of Righteousness).

For every correct answer, a point is awarded. Both the statements and answers must go in quick succession. Let's see if you can score 100% on our RAPID FIRE TRIVIA!

Parents: Prepare a list of 10 to 15 statements that your child can answer. Here some examples:

- ✓ I must consistently do what is right
- ✓ It's ok to tell a lie to avoid punishment
- ✓ I must get all the things my friends have
- ✓ I can talk back to my mom once I do it quietly

PARENTS' TIPS
